The Technical Director is responsible for the realization of scenery, including mechanical and technical solutions, for more than 14 Globe productions including musicals, Shakespeare, and new works. Position works collaboratively with the designer, director, and other production departments to support the production designs and achieve the intended aesthetic of each show at the highest standard. The Technical Director oversees the work of 15-30 carpenters, painters, craftspeople and assistants at The Old Globe's 14,000 square foot scene shop. Responsibilities include budgeting, hiring and scheduling, technical design, drafting and engineering, and supervision of load-ins, tech processes and strikes.

Ideal applicants will have extensive experience in scenery construction, technical design, engineering, and automation, with demonstrated staff management and progressive budget management experience. The successful applicant will possess extensive knowledge of construction methods, shop and stage operations, rigging, and mechanical design; have superior communication, interpersonal and organizational skills; and be able to creatively problem-solve to meet the Globe's high production standards. This is a terrific opportunity to work with leading designers, a talented and long serving staff, and a well-supported and expanding production department.
